



Q1 Please indicate your company's market cap

Q2 What is your Financial Year End?




Q3 Prior to your most recent AGM, did you engage with the following proxy advisors?




Q5 What time of year did you meet with the proxy advisors? (check as many boxes as applicable)

Q6 Who predominantly attended the meeting(s)?





Q8 How would you rate the quality of the meeting(s) that you had with the following?






